

How to License SQL in the Cloud

About Lume and MS SQL Licensing

- Lume is a Microsoft Authorized Cloud Service Provider offering monthly SPLA Licensing as well as an Authorized Mobility Partner
- As an authorized provider we can sell and deploy SQL on our cloud environment
- You can bring your own SQL licenses with you to the Lume cloud as we are an authorized third-party provider via the Mobility Partner program (*see requirements below*)

SQL Versions and Licensing Options

- Standard and Enterprise versions
 - Available as BYOL (Volume Licensing with SA) or as a monthly SPLA License sold through Lume
 - SQL is priced per Core (virtual or physical)
 - With the per core model, customers do not need to purchase additional client access licenses (CALs) to access the SQL Server Software

 - Bring Your Own License (BYOL) is available with Lume **IF**
 - You purchase Software Assurance through the MS Volume Licensing Program
 - License Mobility through SA allows license reassignment to SQL Server 2019 to a third-party

- Express - Free and available to all customers (see specifications below)
- Web - available as a monthly license sold through Lume via the Service Provider License Agreement
